For Briefing to the Board

A. Governing Board Discussion on Intellectual Property

NORCOM Director Thomas Orr discussed the history of Patent Policy and the need to have a strategy moving forward.

Attorneys Rich Black (Foster Garvey) and Deanna Gregory (Pacifica Law Group) discussed the Intellectual Property Policy, answered questions from the Board, explained the initial process of obtaining a patent, and discussed who is included in the policy.

B. Initial Briefing and Study Session on ZEN Task Force Work

NORCOM Director Thomas Orr discussed the 2020 budget, as well as factors impacting revenue and costs. He discussed the need for NORCOM to plan for possible loss of revenue and increased costs.

NORCOM Fire Liaison Chris Perez discussed the Zone 3/North End Analysis Task Force, presenting the option to mitigate costs by adding new agencies, Renton Regional Fire Authority and Puget Sound Regional Fire Authority. He discussed APCO Retains, Erlang C, and measuring Renton and Puget Sound call volume to assess the impact that it would have on telecommunicator workload and staffing levels.

A. University of Washington Next Generation 911 Summit

NORCOM Deputy Director of Strategic Initiatives Scott Sotobeer discussed the need to establish NORCOM, and search for solutions like RAADAR. He discussed the invitation from the University of Washington to the Next Generation 911 Summit.

NORCOM Director Thomas Orr also discussed the Next Generation 911 Summit, as well as building up NORCOM's reputation, and RAADAR groundwork which will help with revenue.

Deb Flewelling, Government Liaison for the King County 911 Program office discussed the 911 efficiency study.

[•] RCW 42.30.110(1)(i) to discuss with legal counsel representing the agency matters relating to agency enforcement actions, or to discuss with legal counsel representing the agency litigation or potential litigation to which the agency, the governing body, or a member acting in an official capacity is, or is likely to become, a party, when public knowledge regarding the discussion is likely to result in an adverse legal or financial consequence to the agency;

[•] RCW 42.30.110(1)(g) to review the performance of an employee; and

[•] RCW 42.30.110(1)(f) to receive and evaluate complaints brought against an employee.
